1. Expect first-time and cheerful obedience.

Colossians 3:20

- 2. Never discipline in anger.
 - ✓ My kids don't listen if I don't yell.
 - ✓ Shouting is the only way I get respect from my kids.
 - ✓ They won't take me seriously.

What is the difference between discipline and punishment?

Discipline is a way to teach kids to follow rules or correct misbehavior. Punishment is a form of negative discipline.

3. We will discipline properly with instruction.
